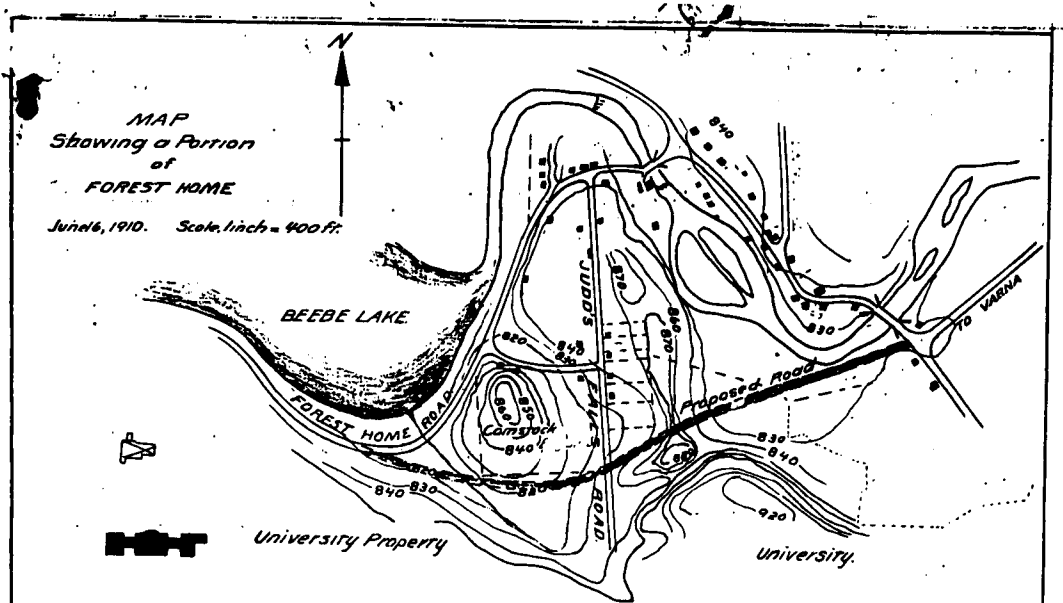


APPENDIX I

1910 Petition from Forest Home
